**YCS After-School Child Care Worker**

Under the supervision of the After School Child Care Coordinator, Yarmouth Community Services Director and Assistant Director, the After School Child Care Worker is responsible for assistant in the programming and supervision of the new after school care program at Yarmouth Elementary School during the 2010-2011 school year. The After School Care Worker will help plan and implement a program of activities for approximately 25 children in grades 2-4, which will ensure each child's personal safety while providing entertainment, physical activities and learning experiences. The After School Care Worker will work closely with Yarmouth Community Services and the Yarmouth School District to ensure that all areas of the job responsibilities reflect the mission of Yarmouth Community Services. Candidates should be a minimum of 21 years of age, with a college degree in a recreation/education field and have experience working with school age children. CPR and First Aid certifications preferred.
