USING ONLY THE MATERIALS LISTED BELOW, BUILD A PAPER CHAIN. YOU MAY CUT YOUR TWO PIECES OF PAPER ANY WAY YOU'D LIKE. YOU WILL HAVE 10 MINUTES TO CONSTRUCT YOUR PAPER CHAIN. AT THE END OF THE TEN MINUTES, SPREAD OUT YOUR PAPER CHAIN ON THE GROUND AND MEASURE YOUR CHAIN WITHOUT TOUCHING IT. IF THE CHAIN BREAKS DURING THE MEASUREMENT PROCESS ONLY THE LONGEST REMAINING PIECE WILL BE MEASURED.

MATERIALS: TWO PIECES OF 8 ½ X 11 COPY PAPER, SCISSORS AND 12 INCHES OF MASKING TAPE.
