THE LATCHSTRING AWARD

Yarmouth is a town with a rich history of volunteerism and community engagement. We feel strongly that the Latchstring Park should be a place of pride in which to applaud these contributions.

Latchstring Park takes its name from our town motto, “Our Latchstring Always Out.” It is intended as an acknowledgement of those citizens whose examples of citizenship and leadership keep Yarmouth a warm and welcoming community of caring individuals. This seems fitting since the park sits at a gateway into Main Street and is a place where we celebrate the recipients of the Latchstring Award with a monument in their honor. Since 1980, the Town Council has annually recognized citizens of Yarmouth who have contributed their time, efforts and concern for an extended and exemplary period for the benefit of the residents of Yarmouth.

The monument will be placed centrally for visibility and prominence, with plenty of space for the annual award ceremony to occur on site.
