

Greetings Clipper Day Camp Families,

Summer camp is almost here, and we can't wait to meet your kids, make new memories, and have lots of fun! As we prepare, we wanted to send along some important information.

Clipper Day Camp will be based out of Harrison Middle School. We will be utilizing the gym, cafeteria, Winslow Fields, and paved recess area when spending time at camp. Regular camp hours are 9:00 am – 3:00 pm. If your child is registered for early care, you may drop them off as early as 7:30 am. If your child is registered for late care, you may pick-up your child as late as 5:30. If you are arriving late to camp in the morning, please check the field trip schedules to ensure they do not miss departure times for field trips. Busses will not be able to wait for late campers.

If you need to reach Clipper Day Camp during camp hours, please call (207) 807-4529. The camp phone will not be checked during non-camp hours. You may also reach the YCS office at (207) 846-2406 from 8:30-4:30, Monday-Friday.

Drop-off/Pick-Up Procedures

When the weather is cooperating, drop-off and pick-up will be conducted outside. A check-in/out table will be set up in the paved recess area. Every child must be signed-in/out unless you have granted permission on your camper information forms for your child to walk or bike to/from camp. If you have granted them permission to walk/bike home, please let our staff know what time you would like us to release them from camp.

When the weather is not cooperating, drop-off and pick-up will be conducted at the entrance indicated in the attached photo. If you do not see a Clipper Care staff member at the entrance when you arrive, please text the Clipper Camp phone at (207) 807-4529 and someone will meet you at the door to assist you.

Required Camper Paperwork

If you haven't already done so, please take a few minutes to fill out the [required camper information form](#). **You will not be able to leave your child at camp until this form is completed. Having this form completed before your child's first day of camp drastically speeds up the drop-off process.**

Lunch Crunch

Lunch Crunch will be providing free lunches to children at Clipper Day Camp for those who qualify. If you have filled out a free/reduced lunch form with the school department this school year, you already

qualify. If not, you'll need to fill out the form at the link below and return to YCS. Those who do not qualify for free lunch, will have the option to register for lunches at \$20/week for 5 days or \$12/week for 3 days. **For the 3 day option, you must indicate at registration which days your child will be a camp.** Meals will be prepared at the HMS kitchen and distributed to campers who have registered. Registration for Lunch Crunch meals at Clipper Day Camp is due one week in advance, the Monday before each week of camp. [Click here](#) to register for Lunch Crunch.

COVID Guidelines

Currently, masks are optional at Clipper Day Camp, except for our time at the Children's Museum, which currently has a mask requirement to enter. We will continue to monitor community transmission rates and update you of any changes.

We are following [CDC guidelines for quarantines/isolation](#). If someone has a known exposure to COVID-19 and they are not vaccinated, they need to quarantine for 5 days from date of exposure and wear a mask through 10 days. If they have a known exposure and are vaccinated (or had confirmed COVID-19 within the past 90 days), they do not need to quarantine but would need to wear a mask for 10 days from the date of exposure.

If someone has COVID-19 they would need to stay home for at least 5 days from on the onset of symptoms, or 5 days after a positive test if they are asymptomatic. If they have symptoms, they are allowed to return to camp after 5 days if their symptoms are improving and they have been fever-free for 24 hours (without the use of fever reducing medicine), but would need to wear a mask until 10 days have passed from the onset of symptoms/positive test result.
