We all know children are guided by their own curiosity, that they learn through play, discovery and collaboration. Campers will also have the opportunity to create and find the elements and principles of art, in nature, crafting, poetry and sound.

Our fab teen council are Camp Soci and Art Attack veterans, circling back, creating extra fun and adventures. Each week at Camp Soci will have a different focus, but every week we will wade, dig, build, listen, meditate, sing sea shanties and have adventures. We will visit the Listening Tree, 72 Step Beach, Ice Age Encampment, Bauhaus Oak and West Side Trail. We will look for, and sometimes see, seals, herons, egrets, eagles, hermit and horseshoe crabs, ospreys and hawks. Handmade field guides will record and paint our entry into this special natural world. Camp Soci invents original games and treasure hunts, build huts and teepees and eco bug palaces.
