- **Spring/Summer Activity Guide**
  - We have released a digital version of our [Spring/Summer Activity Guide](#)
    - Online Registration begins April 1<sup>st</sup>, phone/walk-in registration begins April 5<sup>th</sup>, non-resident registration begins April 12<sup>th</sup>
- **Spring Program Updates**
  - Grades 3-6 lacrosse league will be an in-house league instead of the usual travel league
  - Tee Ball and Instructional League Baseball are set to begin in late April
    - Tee Ball registration numbers are the highest I've seen since I started at YCS in 2011
  - Ramblers Running will be in-house only for the spring season
  - April Vacation Camp is close to filling (29/30 spots taken)
  - Free Girls Lacrosse Clinics are being offered by Jill Thomas/Dorothy Holt (3/15, 3/17, 3/22, 3/24)
  - Offering two sessions of American Red Cross Babysitting course
  - Chris Strong is offering sessions of Total Athlete Training for the spring and summer
  - If school goes back to all-in in May, Meg Pachuta will be offering outdoor Fitness Fun and outdoor Game on Girls
  - If fields are available, Mike Hagerty would like to offer some spring soccer clinics (waiting on school to let us know which fields they will be using)
- **Summer Program Updates**
  - We currently have 36 (and counting) summer camps being planned for this year
  - Three adult trips are being planned for the summer
  - Lunch Crunch will be offered this summer, delivery only
  - We are hoping to resume limited field trips for Clipper Day Camp this year, if conditions allow
  - Planning to do 4 kids shows, 7 family friendly music options and 2 movie nights
- **Clipper Care Full Day Options**
  - We have received permission to remain at the Masonic Lodge for our Thursday/Friday program through the end of the school year, or until school is all-in on those days
  - If the schools decide to switch to all-in on Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays and Fridays, we will continue to offer our Wednesday, full day program
  - If the school department decides to switch to an all-in model, we will be challenged to meet the demand for our before and after care programs and will likely need to hire additional staff
