1. Spring Summer Activity Guide: Mike and Lori reviewed the Spring and Summer activity offerings

- 36 camps added, close to a normal (Non-Covid) summer
- Signup begins online April 1; phone and walk-ins happen April 5
- Popular programs that are oversubscribed will be lottery
- Some programs are smaller or in different formats than in previous years
- Guide was digital edition only this year, due to COVID
- · Guide is still evolving, as more camps added
- 3 Adult trips planned; plus Piyo and Pickleball for adults
- Remote programs did not end up being popular. Some cancelled due to low registration
- YCS working with state on COVID protocols
- Full Day Childcare for remote learning days provided a source of revenue during the year.
 - Grants allowed YCS to offer cost-friendly offerings.
 - YCS Staff is administering the program.
 - 30 kids enrolled Wednesdays, 20 kids enrolled Thursdays and Fridays (Enrollment limited due to small nature of Masonic Lodge)
- Some activities like Lacrosse & Ramblers will stay local to help prevent stop of COVID
- April vacation camp is full.
- Red Cross Babysitting class full with a wait list
- Lunch Crunch: Converted to home delivery last year. Went from 3,000 meals to 13,000 meals.
 No kid programming, due to COVID/volunteers
- Summer Art Series: 3 kid-friendly concerts on mornings in the summer (as in typical summers), plus 7 evening concerts (3 more than usual).
- 2 Movies in the Park

Future Programming:

• Get feedback from community on what programming is in demand — promote the online survey online and at in-person events, as well as through Leigh's newsletter and Town media
